### **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT (Session 2017-2018, 10th HKIE FE Anniversary) ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of the HKIE FIRE Division**

It is my great honor to serve the HKIE Fire Division in the capacity of Chairman for the Session 2017/2018. This year also marks the 10th Anniversary of the establishment of the Fire Division.

Our goals were set down at the onset of the Session, namely

1. Promoting the Fire Engineering in the local building industry is always our common goal.
2. Registered Fire Engineers (RFE) – As one of the major stakeholders in Fire Engineering, the Fire Division supports the Fire Services (Amendment) Bill 2016. We contemplate only the competent persons should be qualified as RFE. Competence comprises professional knowledge, skill, and ability to perform the requisite task, in particular, professionals who possess adequate knowledge of Fire Engineering with relevant training and experience should be registered as RFE. Formal and informal meetings amongst Fire Services Department, Institution of Fire Engineers and Government Bureau were held to pave the way for RFE.

Not only we have our regular CPD courses, technical visits, overseas visit and symposium, we are also acting more interactively with other institutions such as joint seminar with HKIE Building Services Division on FSD approval process, Joint organizers with Institution of Fire Engineers Hong Kong Branch, the Hong Kong Fire Services Department (HKFSD), the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers (Building Services Division), the Ambulance Service Institute (Hong Kong Branch) and the China Hong Kong Fire protection Association for Fire Asia 2018, and Joint Comprehensive Certificate Course (JCCC) on Fire Services Systems in Smart City 2018.

Riding on the success of the Past Chairmen and Committees, we create changes in a quiet and seamless manner.

I would like to express my heartfelt thanks to all members of the Fire Division Committee members for their dedicated effort and unflinching support leading to the fruitful achievements of the Session. With their contributions and collaborative efforts, high quality activities were delivered to the audiences. It is my great honor to work with the dedicated Committee members totally committed to achieve the tasks.

Currently, 792 members are now in the HKIE Fire Division.

The report of Fire Division for the year-plan activities is shown in Appendix which encompasses technical talks, visits and seminars for the Session 2017-2018. Nonetheless, activity highlights are appended for ease of reference:

### CPD Courses

The CPD courses commencing from 23 Jan 2018 to 29 Mar 2018 had been successfully conducted with more than 100 to 200 participants. The CPD course covers: Importance of Reaction to Fire Properties of Materials - Combustibility, Spread of Flame and Smoke Generation; Fire Protection in Curtain Wall and Facade Systems; Theories of Fire Dynamics & Field Test; CFD Modelling for Smoke Movement; Quantitative Fire Risk Analysis; Building Evacuation Modelling; Roles of Fire Services Department in Processing of General Building Plans and Acceptance Inspection Under the Buildings Ordinance, Cap123; Implementation of the Fire Safety (Commercial Premises) Ordinance, Cap. 502 and Fire Safety (Buildings) Ordinance, Cap. 572, Laws of Hong Kong.

### 10th Anniversary Annual Dinner of Fire Division

The dinner was successfully held on 14 November 2017 at the Intercontinental Hotel Hong Kong. A keynote speech was given by the Guest of Honor Legco Member Ir Dr LO Wai kwok. Ir Dr LO appreciated the contribution and development of fire engineering in building industry and the future trends of having Registered Fire Engineers to serve the community. The dinner was well received by more than 500 guests and members to have a joyful and happy moment to celebrate the 10th anniversary.

### 10th Annual Symposium

Due to the Fire Asia (Main theme is Join Hands Towards A New Era of Safety) to be held in May 2018, in order to have a better arrangement for the practitioners, the 10th Annual Symposium of Fire Division was scheduled to be held in September 2018 and the venue has been fixed in Hong Kong PolyU Jockey Club Theatre. The main theme of the Annual Symposium is “Rejuvenization of Existing Building”. Ir Dr CHEUNG Tin-Cheung, JP Director of Buildings has accepted to be our Guest of Honor and will deliver a speech to officiate at the opening ceremony.
